Troop 22's COVID Protocol & Pre-Screening Requirements (until further notice)

For every Troop 22 outing/event/meeting the following policy has been put into place:

- Social Distancing as best possible at all times, Avoid physical contact
- Mask (face coverings) must be worn at all times, unless actively doing something which prevents it, (i.e. swimming, etc). If an activity is physically demanding, sufficient breaks should be taken which allow for 10' social distancing so masks may be temporarily removed. An activity may also be structured to maintain at least 10' social distancing (i.e. cycling) so mask may be removed until the social distancing is not possible, and masks must be put back on.
- Hand washing/sanitized often
- Scouts/Family who travel from a state on the NJ Travel Advisory within 14 days of an event must refrain from participating, until quarantine is over.
- The Covid-19 Pre-Screening Form MUST be filled out the day PRIOR and day OF event and turned in to the Leader running the event.
- All participants will be subject to a 'No Touch" thermometer reading upon arrival, prior to participation, and if warranted during event.
- Any participant who displays a temperature reading of 100.4 degrees
 Fahrenheit before or during the event will be sent home.
